



Preschool Prioritization Policy and Procedures

Plato Academy Preschool is a private provider of preschool programs and the Florida Voluntary Prekindergarten Program.

Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) Registration is accepted on the following basis of priority:

- Plato Academy employee's children
- Currently enrolled Pre-K 3 students (at the same campus they are applying to) seeking VPK Program with wrap-around care (if applicable)
- Eligible students with currently enrolled siblings (at the same campus they are applying to) seeking VPK Program with wrap-around care
- Eligible students seeking VPK Program with wrap-around care
- Currently enrolled Pre-K 3 students (at the same campus they are applying to) seeking VPK morning care program only (if applicable)
- Eligible students with currently enrolled siblings (at the same campus they are applying to) seeking VPK morning care program only
- Eligible students seeking VPK morning care program only

Preschool (Pre-K 3) Registration is accepted on the following basis of priority:

- Plato Academy employee's children
- Eligible students with currently enrolled siblings seeking full-time Pre-K 3 Program (5 days per week)
- Eligible students seeking full-time Pre-K 3 Program (5 days per week)
- Eligible students with currently enrolled siblings seeking morning only Pre-K 3 Program
- Eligible students seeking Pre-K 3 morning care program only

Final enrollment to the VPK and/or Pre-K 3 programs offered by Plato Academy Preschools is not finalized until all Registration Fees, Supply Fees, and required paperwork have been submitted to and approved by Plato Academy Preschool. Programs and availability vary by location and may be subject to change.
